## OSO PARKWAY BRIDGE WIDENING PROJECT RESUMES

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has announced that work on the Oso Parkway Interchange Project's bridge widening on Interstate 5 at Oso Parkway, in the cities of Mission Viejo and Laguna Hills, will resume the week of February 1, 2011.

Caltrans officials made the decision to suspend the project to allow the Southern California Gas Company sufficient time to complete the relocation of its 30-inch line. The relocation was successfully completed in December 2010, allowing Caltrans construction crews to begin completion of this project.

Pile driving operations will begin on Monday, February 7, 2011 and will continue for two weeks. Work will be during daytime hours from 6am to 5pm and there will be no lane closures. Caltrans will continue to provide updates to the public should any future lane closures or detours be necessary. The project now has a revised completion date of September 2011.

In a construction zone, motorists are reminded to *“slow for the cone zone”* be alert, and proceed with caution.
